GRADING POLICY

QUARTER & SEMESTER GRADING

Quarter and Semester grades for band are determined from the following categories:

- 30% Performance Participation
- 25% Daily Class Participation
- 25% Individual Assessments
- 20% Sectional Participation
- Note: The final exam/activity will count for 10% of the student's final semester grade.

EXTRA CREDIT OPPORTUNITIES

A variety of Extra-Credit opportunities will be available for students each semester. Extra credit may be applied the Daily Class Participation category to supplement the student's semester grade.

HONORS (A+) GRADE

An Honors (A+) Grade is available for students that maintain a minimum 95% grade percentage throughout each quarter (without extra credit points).

Grading Categories & Expectations Concert Band & Symphonic Band

Quarter and Semester grades for band are determined from the following categories:

- 30% Performance Participation
- 25% Daily Class Participation
- 25% Individual Assessments
- 20% Sectional Participation
- Note: The semester final exam/activity will count for 10% of the student's final (semester) grade.

PERFORMANCES (30%)

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- Home Concert Performances / State Large Ensemble Festival
 - *300 Points Possible* (per performance)
 - 75 Points Correct Concert Attire
 - 75 Points On Time/Warm-Up
 - 100 Points Performance Participation
 - 50 Points Post-Performance Attendance / Stage Strike
- Dress Rehearsals / Extra Rehearsals (Adds 100 points to respective performance) Example: Night of Bands, State Large Ensemble Festival
 - o 100 Points Possible (per rehearsal)
 - 25 Points All Materials Needed (Music/Reeds/Mutes/Pencil/etc.)
 - 25 Points On Time (Downbeat of Warm-Up)
 - 50 Points Participation/Rehearsal Etiquette
 - NOTE: Inappropriate cell phone use during rehearsal will result in a "0" rehearsal grade.

DAILY CLASS PARTICIPATION (25%)

• Daily Class Rehearsals

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Full Band Rehearsals

- 10 Points Possible (Per Daily Rehearsal)
 - 3 Points On-Time (Downbeat of Warm-Up)
 - 2 Points All Materials Needed (Music/Reeds/Mutes/Pencil/etc.)
 - 5 Points Participation/Rehearsal Etiquette
 - NOTE: Inappropriate cell phone use during rehearsal will result in a "0" daily grade.

INDIVIDUAL ASSESSMENTS (25%)

• Performance Evaluations

Individual performance evaluations including, but not limited to: Seating evaluations, scale evaluations, musical excerpt evaluations

• Point Values Vary

• Written Assignments

• Point Values Vary

SECTIONAL COACHING (20%)

This grade component is determined by sectional coaches and is based upon participation (as described below) and personal improvement throughout the quarter/semester.

- 10 Points Possible (Per Daily Rehearsal)
 - 3 Points On-Time (Downbeat of Warm-Up)
 - 2 Points All Materials Needed (Music/Reeds/Mutes/Pencil/etc.)
 - 5 Points Participation/Rehearsal Etiquette
 - NOTE: Inappropriate cell phone use during rehearsal will result in a "0" daily grade.

HONORS (A+) GRADE

An Honors (A+) Grade is available for students that possess "good standing" within the band program and meet the following criteria:

- Maintain a minimum **95% grade percentage** throughout each quarter (without extra credit points)
- Final grade calculation must meet or exceed 120% (with extra credit)
- No unexcused tardies
- No unexcused absences

CHS Pep Band

All students enrolled in CHS Band Classes participate in the CHS Football Pep Band. All rehearsals and performances (including Homecoming events) are required and are calculated in the quarter/semester grades. The Pep Band performs pre-game, throughout the entire game, and post-game.

Expectations

• Attendance

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- Attendance at each rehearsal and performance is required
- If unable to attend any rehearsal or performance, it is the student's responsibility to inform Ms. Shelley at least one day in advance of the absence.
 - Parents may contact Ms. Shelley if necessary.
 - All excused absences must be approved by Ms. Shelley.
 - Ms. Shelley reserves the right to excuse or not excuse any absence.
- Grading
 - Football Pep Band is a component of CHS Band Curriculum and is included in quarter/semester grades.
 - All components of the grading system apply to pep band participation and performance.
 - Football Games and Homecoming Parade are considered performances and are graded as such.
- Extra Credit
 - Extra Credit will be available for participation at post-season playoff games.

EXTRA CREDIT OPPORTUNITIES

Extra Credit is calculated at the end of each Academic Semester. Extra Credit earned will be added to the *Class Participation* component of the quarter/semester grade categories. *All Extra Credit Forms must be completed and returned by the indicated deadline in order to receive credit.* ***All Extra Credit Forms will be located online through Mr. Nichols & Ms. Shelley's CHS Website.*

All Year (Continuous)

- Private Lessons
 - Weekly lessons on primary instrument
 - 20 Points 1 hour lesson
 - 15 Points 45 minute lesson
 - 10 Points 1/2 Hour lesson
 - Weekly lessons on any secondary lesson/voice
 - 10 Points Any lesson regardless of length of lesson

Brass Choir/Woodwind Choir/Percussion Ensemble

- Rehearsals and Performance as scheduled
 - 10 Points Rehearsal
 - 50 Points Performance

• Additional Ensembles

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- Examples: St. Louis Symphony Youth Orchestra, Webster Community School ensembles, Clayton Symphony Orchestra, church ensembles that rehearse and perform weekly
 - 50 Points Per ensemble / Per quarter
- Additional Concert Attendance
 - o Examples: St. Louis Symphony concert, Fox Theater concert, Wydown Middle School concert,
 - 10 Points per event

• Mentoring (By teacher recommendation only)

- Clayton schools beginning music student
- Must maintain a journal of the lesson scope and student improvement
- o Lessons are free (no money exchanged) for half-hour lessons
- Fees may be negotiated for lessons over 30 minutes
 - 10 points per weekly lesson
- Service
 - o Examples: Sorting/Filing music, assisting with inventory, moving equipment, room set-up, etc
 - 1 Point per minute of service


