On March 23, 2020 CHS pivoted to virtual learning. Students followed the same schedules, meeting with the same teacher in a virtual classroom. CHS adopted a "hold harmless" policy, and students were issued a grade for the second semester. Emphasis was placed on the grade for third quarter which was completed before virtual learning began. If all student coursework was complete for fourth-quarter student's grades were reflective of the work they had done in the previous, in-person setting. There were no final exams administered in the spring of 2020.

Starting August 2021 CHS permanently adopted the block schedule that was implemented to mitigate COVID 19. This is a traditional block schedule with 85 minute class periods that meet every other day.

CHS continues to focus on maintaining the rigorous curriculum that is a tradition at our school.

Accredited by the North Central Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools, Clayton High School has received the highest rating by the Missouri Division of Public Schools.

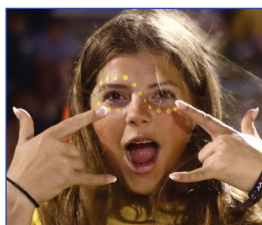
