# **CURRICULUM**

Clayton High School follows a traditional block schedule with 85 minute class periods that meet every other day. The block schedule allows CHS to provide the rigorous curriculum and high academic standards that is a tradition at our school.

CHS is committed to maintaining the tradition of academic rigor that defines our school. Honors and Advanced Placement courses are offered across all disciplines. More than 98% of students complete four years of English, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies. Within the English curriculum, students are required to produce five major papers each semester. Each paper is individually reviewed in conference with the teacher and revised based on constructive feedback. To support this process, English teachers are assigned three instructional periods per days, with the remaining time dedicated to student conferences and instructional planning.
