

# School District of Clayton Courtesy Wireless Access

The SDC Courtesy WiFi network is provided as a convenience for staff, students, and guests to connect personal, non-district-managed devices. Security requirements prohibit devices on this network from interacting with other networked devices including wireless presentation systems such as AirTame, VIA, ClearTouch, etc.. All users of the courtesy network must agree to the district's Terms and Conditions before use.

## Employees and Students

Connections will stay active for 30 days at a time. A maximum of 1 device per user is allowed on the courtesy network

- Connect your device to the "SDC Courtesy WiFi" network and permit your device to redirect to the network login page
- Click the blue Staff or Student button on the login page
- Enter your school username (exclude the @claytonschools.net) and password
- Read and accept the terms of use, and click Log In

## Guests (and staff without a district account)

(A valid email address AND a cellular phone w/text messaging service is REQUIRED. Connections will stay active for 24 hours at a time. A maximum of 1 device per user is allowed on the courtesy network. This network is highly filtered)

- Connect your device to the "SDC Courtesy WiFi" network and permit your device to redirect to the network's login page
- Click the orange "Guest Registration" button.
- Complete the form to register, read and accept the terms of use and click Register
- Go back to the "Guest Registration" page and click the blue Sign in button.

## District Web Filtering

The School District of Clayton applies a web content filtering service to all web pages accessed from the District network. This includes sites accessed while at school and, for district-provided devices or when using district credentials, sites accessed at home or other locations. The service operates by blocking access to any URLs matching a list of blocklisted addresses and/or uncategorized content. The blocklist is assembled, updated and maintained by the content filtering software used by the School District of Clayton. The software is designed, at a minimum, to seek out and block websites with the following categories of content.

- Violence
- Hate/Racism
- Nudism
- Pornography
- Adult/Mature Content
- Drugs/Illegal Drugs
- Gambling
