

Student Privileges Information

The Center of Clayton is an independently operated community recreation center attached to Clayton High School that serves those who live and work in the region. The City of Clayton and the School District of Clayton fund capital improvements and manage the facilities. However, all operational costs are covered by membership and admission fees. Clayton High School students are granted the privilege of using The Center on school days as outlined below.

Student Privileges

SCHOOL DAYS (7:15 am - 4:30 pm)

Starting the first school day after Labor Day, CHS students may access The Center of Clayton on days when school is in session between 7:15 a.m .and 4:30 p.m. This privilege is not granted on snow days or scheduled days off.

AFTER SCHOOL, WEEKENDS & HOLIDAYS

Students who wish to use the Center before or after the times above or on a day when school is not in session must have a current membership or pay the daily admission fee. Students are not permitted to loiter in the lobby after 4:30 p.m.

TEMPORARY CLOSURES

The Clayton High School Administration may periodically limit student access to the Center at their discretion. Common instances include inclement weather, disciplinary incidents, and peak times during the winter sports season.

Center Card Required

For the safety of all our patrons, all who enter the Center, including CHS students, are required to present a valid Center of Clayton card when entering the building at either the CHS Door or the Welcome Desk. Cards can be obtained at the Welcome Desk during normal operation hours.

Food & Drink

Food and drink is only permitted in main lobby. Any patrons, including students, seen eating in other areas of the building such as the gymnasium will be asked to return to the lobby or school cafeteria.

When using the lobby, students should clean up after themselves when they have finished.

Changing

Students should use the appropriate locker room for all changing purposes:

During School	High School Locker Rooms
Before & After School (Member/Admission)	Member Locker Rooms
Team Practice/Games	Team Locker Rooms

Restrooms should not be used for changing purposes.

Valuables

All patrons should keep valuables stored and locked at all times. Belongings left unattended will be relocated to the Center's lost and found. The Center of Clayton is not responsible for lost or stolen items. A designated area for backpacks will be located in the fitness center.

Proper Conduct

Since the Center is host to all ages and backgrounds, all patrons expected to abide by a proper code of conduct. Any patrons, including students, exhibiting behaviors such as the following will be asked to leave and may be subject to further disciplinary action based on the School and Center guidelines:

- Abusive/hostile actions towards others or employees
- · Disruptive inappropriate behavior
- · Facility use without proper membership
- Fighting
- Gambling
- Personal training by outside trainers
- Tampering with safety and security equipment
- Theft
- Under the influence of alcohol/drugs
- Vandalism/destruction of property (including hanging on basketball rims)
- Violation of dress code
- Weapons on property
