WHO should participate in FOCUS?

All School District of Clayton community members, including parents, students, staff, alumni and District residents, are encouraged to participate. Let's **FOCUS** together as the success of this project relies heavily on participation from a broadbased representation of our community.

WHY should our community participate in FOCUS?

Your opinion matters. This is an opportunity for the District to hear your voice - our community's voice for our students' future. Attend an Open House to learn about the District's current financial reality and also take some time to help shape priorities for our students' future. Most importantly, attendees will have the opportunity to ask questions, share ideas and provide feedback.

FOCUS ON OUR FINANCIAL HEALTH

The School District of Clayton Board of Education is studying the possibility of asking voters to approve a tax levy increase in April 2019. The District's last voter-approved tax increase was in April 2003. Prop E, the name of the 2003 ballot proposal, was projected to last for three years. Due to sound fiscal management, including budget reductions, cost control measures and steps to reduce utility costs, it has lasted for nearly 16 years. However, because of a state law that limits the growth of a school district's tax revenue, the District has seen expenses grow at a considerably faster rate than revenues over

time. This growth in expenses resulted in annual budget shortfalls beginning with the 2015-2016 school year. The District has been prudently using its reserves to close the gap between revenues and expenses for the past three years. While new construction creates some additional new revenue for the District, it only represents on average about two percent of the District's operating revenue and will not be enough to close the revenue/expenditure gap. Therefore, the District is exloring the possibility of asking voters to approve a tax increase in April 2019.

FOCUS ON OUR STUDENTS

FOCUS will also allow the Clayton community to provide input to help establish priorities for our students' future. These community priorities will not only be used to inform important decisions being made by the Board of Education but will also be used as building blocks to develop the District's next strategic plan. In addition to gathering input at the Open Houses, the District will be using a platform called ThoughtExchange, which will allow students, parents, staff, alumni and community members to provide their thoughts on priorities for our students and evaluate others' thoughts in a transparent, online conversation.
