Parent/Student Initiated Virtual Learning Process

Parent/guardian/student indicates interest (to the school) in enrolling in a virtual course during the normal school course enrollment window.



School provides enrollment information to parent/guardian, who completes the appropriate forms (electronic or paper).



School team (or IEP/504 team) reviews the enrollment request and makes a "best educational interest" determination.



Request approved; school begins the process of enrolling the student with the virtual learning vendor.

Principal informs the parent/guardian/student in writing the "good cause" basis on which the request is not approved.



Parent/guardian can appeal or accept the school's decision.
