We have added a 15-minute period (Greyhound Time) between periods two and three which will allow students an opportunity to check in with their teachers, grab a snack, go to their locker, take a walk, etc.

- On the last Wednesday of each month (starting in September) we will be adding a 30minute period (Clayton Conversations) for student-led building wide conversations.

It will be interesting to pilot these changes as we examine a larger schedule change in 2020-2021. We will do this in conjunction with a significant change to the yearly
