IMPORTANT INFORMATION

PARTICIPATION

Enrollment in Elementary Summer Academy (ESA) is by teacher recommendation only for students currently enrolled in the School District of Clayton. There are three different programs for which students are recommended:

- **Academic Support** is designed for students entering first through fifth grade who need the continuation of instruction during the summer to maintain and reinforce skills in reading, writing and math.
- **English Language Support** is designed for English Language Learners entering first through fifth grade who need the continuation of instruction during the summer to maintain and reinforce their skills in English speaking, listening, reading, writing and acculturation. Students will learn in the general education setting with support from English Language teachers.
- **Extended School Year (ESY)** is designed for special education students for whom extended year services have been identified in the student's Individual Education Plan (IEP).

DATES AND TIMES

ESA is a morning-only program. It is held on weekdays, June 8 - July 2. All ESA drop-offs are at Glenridge Elementary. Students will have the option to spend the remainder of the day in the SummerQuest recreation program. Students enrolled in ESY will meet during the morning session until 11:30 a.m. unless they are participating in SummerQuest in the afternoon.

- ESA hours: 8:30 - 11:05 a.m.
- Transition/Lunch: 11:05 - 11:45 a.m.

LOCATION

ESA will be located at Glenridge Elementary School, 7447 Wellington Way. The facility is fully air-conditioned and includes the use of the library and computer labs.

COSTS

There is no fee for students currently enrolled in the District, with the exception of personal tuition students and tax-credit tuition students, for whom the fee is \$500. Full payment is due with your registration form.

School District of Clayton students who meet the criteria and are recommended for the academic support program need to attend the **full four weeks of ESA**.

Students who are recommended for ESA will have the option of spending the balance of their day in SummerQuest for a fee of \$225 per two-week session while enrolled in ESA. Full scholarships are available for students enrolled in the Federal Free or Reduced-Price Meal Program. Please contact Julie Engelhard at 854-6023 for more details.

BEFORE & AFTER CARE

We offer a fee-based before and after care program from 7-8:15 a.m. and 3:30-6 p.m. at Clayton High School (CHS). Students are transported to/from ESA by bus from/to CHS. Our staff will greet early arrivals with breakfast and will be ready to play in the open gym, computer lab and recreation area. Students who wish to extend their day will receive a healthy snack and can play in the open gym and recreation area.

- Before Care: \$200
- After Care: \$300

BREAKFAST & LUNCH

Breakfast is available for purchase from 8:20-8:30 a.m. If your child is attending before care, breakfast is provided at no cost. Lunch is included for students participating in both ESA and SummerQuest.

TRANSPORTATION

Drop-off and pickup will be at the school's main entrance. The carpool lanes are well-supervised. Students participating in both ESA and SummerQuest will be transported to CHS by bus. VICC will provide bus transportation to voluntary transfer students participating in ESA.
