

“Calculators for Kids” Program Rental Agreement

At Clayton, a graphing calculator is a vital part of every student’s mathematics education. Your student needs to have access to a graphing calculator, both during class and elsewhere for homework. Additionally, graphing calculators such as the **TI-Nspire CX** are allowed on standardized tests such as the SAT and ACT.

The Clayton Math Department has instituted a program to make a graphing calculator affordable for students. For a rental fee of \$30, students may check out a graphing calculator with additional accessories for an entire school year, provided the student and his or her parent or guardian agree to the following terms:

1. Calculators will be provided with cover, cable & charger.
2. The student agrees not to modify any Clayton markings on the calculator.
3. The student and parent/guardian agree to return the calculator with additional accessories by the last day of the current school year, or pay a replacement fee of up to \$130 for a lost, stolen, or damaged calculator that no longer functions.

How will my \$30 rental fee be used?

The monies earned through rentals will be used to purchase more calculators for the program or to replace older calculators.

What if the \$30 rental fee is difficult for my family?

Please contact your mathematics teacher. The math department wants every student to have the tools necessary for success and will be flexible with payments or even help secure calculator rental scholarships for students with financial need.

Is every student eligible for this program?

No. The Math Department simply does not have enough graphing calculators to supply every student with one. We do ask that if you are capable of purchasing a graphing calculator for your student that you do so, and allow us to rent calculators to those families having financial need. Calculator rentals will be made on a first-come, first-served basis.

Can I help with this program?

Certainly! You could help sponsor a \$30 scholarship for another family, donate a graphing calculator to the program, or perhaps help put us in contact with an organization willing to donate monies for our program.

Rental Agreement:

I give my student permission to rent a graphing calculator for the current school year at a fee of \$30. I agree that my student will return the calculator with all additional accessories by the last day of school or to pay the replacement fee of \$130 should the calculator become lost, stolen or damaged to the point of non-functioning.
