### Treasurer's Report

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Angela Osborne reported that the current balance is \$45,687.76. Spring Fundraising brought in \$6,425. That is a total of \$26,520 for the year with the goal being \$35,000 in order to fund next year's budget.

The current 7<sup>th</sup> grade class started at Wydown with an extra \$723 in funds that were raised as students at Meremec. \$450 remains as a line item for this class to use before graduating next year.
