Clayton School Board Updates: Stacy Siwak and Leo Human – LRFP UPDATE: Board Meetings are on the board website with presentations from design teams for each building, narrowed it down to 3 areas: elementary schools, new wing at the high school, and athletic facilities (including Wydown track and field). Will have 3 community forums coming up at the Clayton HS Library, survey went out on Friday to gauge interest in the community and tax threshold for a bond issue on the ballot.
