- 3. Budget Overview Bryan Lawrence for Gina Bernstein
 - We are considerably short of our goal of raising \$29K as we have only raised \$21K to date.
 - In addition to the dollars available in this years budget, we have the following reserved funds available from prior years:
 - i. After Prom \$3,949.65
 - ii. Funds for Excellence \$6,244.05
 - Staff appreciation has only raised \$2,825. We had hoped to raise \$4500 however to date, we have not hit that goal. Increasing the budget would require us to take funds from another line on the budget and requires a vote. Therefore if we intend to increase the funds beyond the \$2825 raised, we should start discussions tonight. If anything we may need to change the current plan for Staff Appreciation if the planned expense is greater than \$2825.
