- Enrollment this year is currently 915 which is 20 more than last year. (917 is the past record high)
- The class schedule this year has been modified to include one additional minute of passing time in-between classes for a total of 5 minutes. We have also added daily "Greyhound Time" in-between 2nd and 3rd hour. It is 20 minutes of free time to meet with teachers or attend mental wellness activities.
- At the end of September we will implement C Squared. It is a 30 minute time period on the last Wednesday of each month for Clayton conversations. It will be student led with topics selected by students. There will be two adult staff members in each discussion group. There will be a student advisory group to develop plans and the students will co-facilitate the discussions.
- Recently the state approved changes to the school calendar and how the length of the year is calculated. Two years ago, it was calculated by both days and hours. Moving forward it will be calculated by hours only. Next year the school year cannot begin more than 10 days before Labor Day. In doing so, that creates two unequal semesters and so we are looking at how to address the 21 day difference with the possibility of needing to add to the length of the school day.
- Fall sports are underway and the Football team has 45 students signed up (15 more than last year). The possible cooperative arrangement with Maplewood Richmond Heights Football team did not get approved by MRH school board in time so will revisit the possibility next year.
- Open House is Tuesday, August 20 at 7pm. Freshman Open House is at 6pm.
- Principal Coffees will continue this year. Times and dates TBA.

Committee Reports

- Picture Day is August 22 for Freshman, Sophomores and Juniors.
- Jostens will be present on August 27 to take ring orders for Juniors and Seniors. Caps and Gowns can be ordered then for seniors if they have not already done so.

- Homecoming Spirit Week is September 15-21.
- The Junior Challenge is lead by Seniors and is on September 12.

Treasurer Report

Gina Bernstein presented the current PTO Budget and account balance.

- The Simmons Checking account has \$47,285.84
- The Paypal account has \$9,927.22

- There is a line item showing \$988.40 in the budget for the Senior Class Parent Connections. It is money that they raised last year's clothing sales.
