On March 23, 2020 CHS pivoted to virtual learning. Students followed the same schedules, meeting with the same teacher in a virtual classroom. CHS adopted a "hold harmless" policy, and students were issued a grade for the second semester. Emphasis was placed on the grade for third quarter which was completed before virtual learning began. If all student coursework was complete for fourth-quarter student's grades were reflective of the work they had done in the previous, in-person setting. There were no final exams administered in the spring of 2020.

August 23, 2021 CHS continued a block scheduling that was implemented in 2020 in mitigating COVID-19. This is a traditional block schedule with 85 minute class periods. All CHS courses are in person (as of August 2021).

CHS is continuing with a modified block schedule for the 2022-2023 school year. The focus at CHS is maintaining the rigor of the curriculum that is a tradition at CHS.
