## Recap of Last Month's Meeting



The PTO's most recent meeting was on October 8. Highlights include:

- **BOE Director Ben Beinfeld** gave an overview of the Long-Range Facilities Plan. The next Community Meetings are at CHS on 10/21 and 11/18.
- Treasurer Rob Bertman and Funds for Excellence chair Phil Kilbridge reported that almost \$20,000 has been donated towards the PTO's operating expenses so far. The goal is to raise \$30,000 and fully fund the operating expenses before the end of 2025.
- CHS Principal Dr. Gutchewsky and Coordinator of Athletics and Activities T'Shon Young gave us an overview of Homecoming week. The Fox News Pep Zone was attended by over 300 students, and the Homecoming dance by about 600. Everything was a success. Dr. Gutchewsky also shared information about Clayton High School's Title 1 designation.
- Faculty/Staff Special Project Awards Chairs Bridget McAndrew and Kami Waldman reviewed the PTO's Special Project Award to the Globe, the student news publication, from the 24-25 school year. Applications for Awards for the 25-26 school year are being accepted through November 1.
