

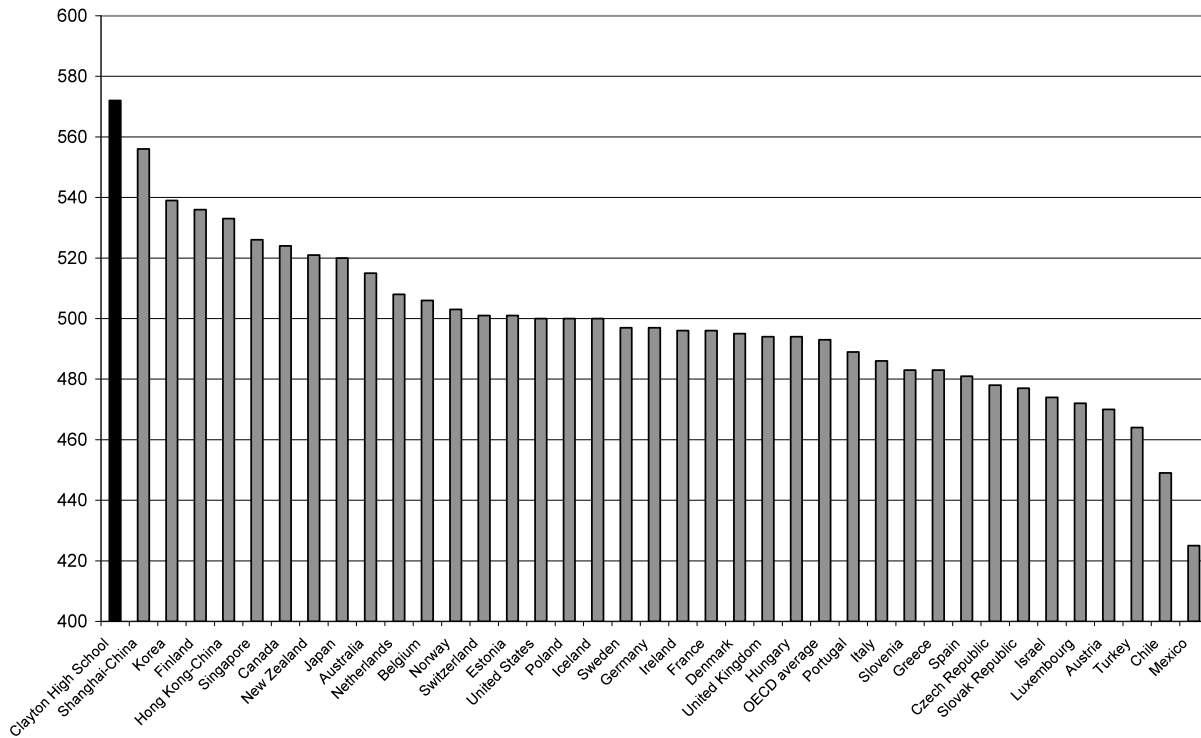

The first column is based on the PISA scores of all CHS tenth graders who took the assessment. The second is based only on those students who turn 15 between Sept. 1, 2009 and Aug. 31, 2010. The practice of limiting the students to 15-year-olds is used by PISA to enhance the validity of comparing scores across nations. The scores for the 15-year-olds are directly comparable to the published values for other countries.

Figure 2b: Average Mathematics Scores of 15-Year-Old CHS Students Compared to Countries Participating in the PISA

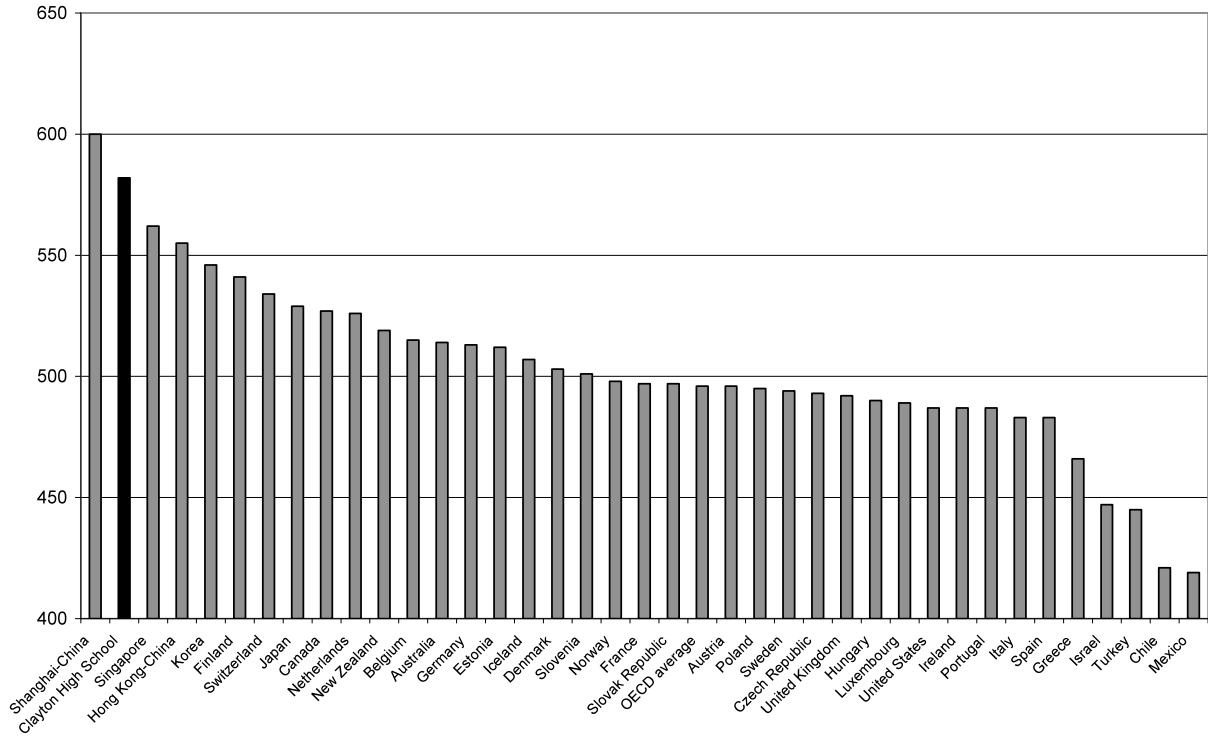


Figure 2c: Average Science Scores of 15-Year-Old CHS Students Compared to Countries Participating in the PISA
