# IMPORTANT INFORMATION

## PARTICIPATION

Enrollment in Elementary Summer Academy (ESA) is by teacher recommendation only for students currently enrolled in the School District of Clayton. There are three different programs for which students are recommended:

- Academic Support is designed for students entering first through fifth grade who need the continuation of instruction during the summer to maintain and reinforce skills in reading, writing and math.
- English Language Support is designed for English Language Learners entering first through fifth grade who need the continuation of instruction during the summer to maintain and reinforce their skills in English speaking, listening, reading, writing and acculturation. Students will learn in the general education setting with support from English Language teachers.
- Extended School Year (ESY) is designed for special education students for whom extended year services have been identified in the student's Individual Education Plan (IEP).

## DATES AND TIMES

ESA is a half-day program held weekdays, June 10-July 8. Students will attend either the AM or PM session. For families that may need childcare, there are a limited number of spaces available through KidZone for the afternoon only. Students enrolled in ESA will meet during these times:

- **AM Session: 8:30 - 11:00 a.m.**
- **PM Session: 12:15 - 2:45 p.m.**

## LOCATION

ESA will be located at Meramec Elementary School, 400 S. Meramec Avenue. The facility is fully air-conditioned and includes the use of the library.

## COSTS

There is no fee for students currently enrolled in the District, with the exception of personal tuition students and tax-credit tuition students, for whom the fee is \$500. Full payment is due with your registration form.

School District of Clayton students who meet the criteria and are recommended for the academic support program need to attend the full four weeks of ESA.

## AFTER CARE

We offer a fee-based aftercare program from 11:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. through Kid Zone. Students will have lunch after their morning session at 11:00 a.m. A limited number of spaces are available

Students in the afternoon will have choices of activities, outside play, inside choice time, and gym play throughout the afternoon. Fees must be paid prior to service.

## TRANSPORTATION

Drop-off and pickup will be at the school's main entrance. The carpool lanes are well-supervised. VICC will provide bus transportation to voluntary transfer students participating in ESA.
