WHEN – Friday, May 14 (AFTERNOON) through Sunday, May 23.

WHERE – Collection bin: the north section of the WMS parking lot

WHAT – Clothing, linens (towels, bedding, curtains), nonwearable clothing, paired shoes, purses, belts, toys.

HOW – Packed as follows: 1) clothing/cloth in trash bags....
2) Toys, shoes, etc. separated from cloth and in either boxes or trash bags
