



MUSIC NOTES

The treble clef (above) are higher sounding notes and the bass clef (below) are the lower sounding notes. Some intruments like the violin, flute, and clarinet only play the treble clef. Other intruments like the cello and tuba only play the bass clef. Instruments like the piano play both clefs. The right hand plays the treble clef and the left plays the bass clef.
