ELEMENTARY SUMMER ACADEMY

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Elementary Summer Academy (ESA) is an academic summer program designed to maintain and reinforce reading, phonics, and math skills for selected Clayton students entering grades 1-5. ESA class sizes are smaller than the traditional school year, enabling staff to provide more personalized instruction. ESA teachers use a project-based learning approach that allows students to develop multiple academic and social emotional skills in hands-on, creative experiences.

PARTICIPATION

Students are invited to participate in ESA based on one or more of the following supports:

- Academic Support - Based on the student's progress during the school year (as measured by grade level expectations and district assessments), the student would benefit from continued instruction to maintain or strengthen their reading, writing, and math skills.
- English Language Support - Based on state screening criteria, the student would make additional progress in language skills with continued support and practice in English speaking, listening, reading, writing, and peer interactions. Students receive support from an English Language teacher in the general education classroom.
- Extended School Year (ESY) - The student has an Individualized Education Program (IEP) that includes additional special education services outside the traditional school schedule.

DAILY EXPERIENCE

ESA meets from 8:30 a.m. to 12 p.m. A typical day might include:

- Community Meeting
- Math Instruction
- Counselor-led Social Emotional Learning Mini-lesson Outdoor Inquiry
- Project Based Learning Block
- Literacy Instruction
- Design Thinking Block

STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

Special School District works individually with families whose students have IEPs that include Extended School Year (ESY) services. An SSD staff member will also be available to assist the District's summer program teams and provide classroom support based on students' needs, regardless of ESY status.

COST

Elementary Summer Academy is free for all students currently enrolled in the School District of Clayton. Students who are enrolled through the District's personal tuition program will be charged \$550 per class.
