WYDOWN SUMMER ACADEMY

The School District of Clayton offers two opportunities for students entering grades 6 - 8 to continue growing personally and academically. Both Leadership Academy and Jump Start Math provide opportunities for summer learning while making connections to other Clayton Students.

WYDOWN LEADERSHIP ACADEMY

Purpose: This experience is intended to serve students entering grades 6 - 8 who are interested in expressing their thoughts and ideas about the world around them through meaningful learning activities and discussions.

Description: Wydown Leadership Academy is a project-based learning experience that allows students to engage in interdisciplinary projects that draw upon their ability to work well with others and in flexible groups. The projects focus on social-emotional learning (SEL) and literacy skills, while deepening students' understanding of civic engagement and current events. Students will engage in two projects. One project will explore the concept of storytelling across cultures through literacy and theater arts, culminating in lively plays and skits which will be performed for the community. An additional STEM-based project involves creativity and inquiry skills in the pursuit of building a minigolf course for community members to enjoy. Each project is selected with the intention to promote intellectual curiosity and provide opportunities for students to realize greater self confidence in their ability to be creative thinkers facing a variety of real world challenges.

JUMP START MATH

Purpose: This experience is intended to serve students who would benefit from additional instruction and practice in preparation for their math experience during the 2024-25 school year.

Intended audience: Students entering grades 6 - 8 who are interested in increased practice and understanding of current grade level math content.

Course Description: This summer experience is designed to provide students with increased practice and understanding of grade level content in preparation for their upcoming math experience. The summer experience will engage students in number sense activities, fluency routines, grade level specific practice and problem solving strategies. Additional emphasis will be placed on developing each student's ability to reason, communicate, represent, and make connections between mathematical concepts.

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STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

Special School District works individually with families whose students have IEPs that include Extended School Year (ESY) services. An SSD staff member will also be available to assist the District's summer program teams and provide classroom support based on students' needs, regardless of ESY status.
