Here's what you need to know for this year's Science Fair!**

(Please note: although science fair projects are not required, all students are welcome and encouraged to participate!)

- ☉ All three elementary schools and Wydown will be having a combined fair again this year!
- ☉ Projects may include experiments, observations, inventions, collections, or models.
- ☉ **All logbooks should include a safety section discussing specific safety guidelines followed, as well as a signed safety form. Find the form at www.sciencefairstl.org.**
- ☉ Projects may be completed independently or in groups of up to three students. All students in the group must turn in their own sign-up sheet and safety form. (Information on all group members' sheets should match.)
- ☉ Scoring guides can be found on the Glenridge Science Fair webpage. Projects receiving blue ribbons will go on to represent Glenridge at the Greater St. Louis Science Fair!
