#### NATIONAL BLUE RIBBON SCHOOLS

#### NICHE K-12 BEST SCHOOLS RANKING



The District was ranked first in Missouri and 13th in the U.S. in the 2019 Niche K-12 ranking of the best schools in America. The District's schools also earned top marks in the statewide ranking.
