## 2. Principal's Report with Dr. Martin

- Solar Eclipse on April 8<sup>th</sup>
  - Will transition from Captain to Concordia starting at 1:00

  - The district purchased the solar glasses for all students and staff (the glasses meet safety standards)

- Missouri Assessment Program is the state test issued between May 1st and 14th

  - Will continue with input process from parents
