

Freshman Offerings for Performing Arts

BAND STUDENTS – Current 8th grade Symphonic Band students should enroll in CHS Concert band for your freshman year. Email <u>alyssaovermann@claytonschools.net</u> for any questions.

JAZZ ENSEMBLE – yes, it is a full credit class offered before school from 7:25-8:05 a.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, & Friday every week. This is by audition, and you must be in another performing arts class as a prerequisite. All Jazz Ensemble & Instrumental Jazz Band students who are interested will rehearse collectively during the first two weeks of school. JAZZ BAND – a ½ credit class offered before school from 7:25-8:05 a.m. on Tuesday & Friday every week. This is a great learning environment for those interested in playing Jazz and serves as a training group for the Jazz Ensemble. This is also a great place for those woodwind or brass players interested in learning a second instrument as well as up and coming guitarists, bass guitarists and pianists. ORCHESTRA STUDENTS - Concert Orchestra is open to all interested students who are experienced string players in grades 9-12. Any student from freshman through senior is welcome to audition for the Symphonic orchestra, which meets only one period a day. Students will only be accepted by audition, which will be held in the next few weeks for 8th graders. Current 8th grade students have been given audition materials. CHOIR STUDENTS – Current 8th grade students should enroll in CHS Concert Choir for their freshman year. Concert Choir members perform on all three choir concerts in addition to the end-of-year graduation ceremony. Concert Choir students are eligible to audition for Show Choir, which meets from 7:25–8:05 a.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, & Thursday each week. Show Choir is a full credit class. DRAMA STUDENTS - Theater Arts is a class focusing on collaborative creation, movement and vocal production. Theater Arts may be scheduled opposite a lab or learning center class. Freshmen are encouraged to audition for Fall Play, the Winter Musical and the Student Run Musical in the Spring.
